



Parent/Guardian Code of Conduct

The mission of the Carly Stowell Foundation (CSF) is to provide enhanced education in athletics and music to young people who demonstrate passion for learning and a commitment to excel. Parents are an integral part of ensuring the children have a positive and enjoyable experience with our league. As a parent, you have the responsibility to help reinforce what the coaches teach: sound athletic technique, sportsmanship and love of the game. The children will see you and the way you react to all situations. It is imperative that your conduct represents yourself and CSF – Jammin' in the best possible way. As a CSF Parent/Guardian, I agree to the following Code of Conduct:

- I will treat all participants with respect, being positive and constructive at all times to players and coaches.
- I will not use abusive or profane language or gestures, and will control my anger at all times.
- I will treat all referees with respect, recognizing that baseball rules involve judgment. I will not openly criticize the referees or participants during the course of the game.
- If I have concerns about players, coaches, referees, courts or any other aspect of CSF – Jammin', I will direct them to the appropriate Official, away from the court.
- I will cheer positively, providing encouragement for members of both teams.
- During the game I will remain off of the court unless requested by the coach to give assistance.
- I will support my child's commitment to the team by assuring his/her attendance at practices and games. I will notify the coach if my child is unable to attend a practice or game.
- I will respect the private property of those living near areas of play, with regard to parking, noise, garbage and trespassing.
- I will not use tobacco products or consume alcoholic beverages during any CSF athletic event.
- Failure to follow this Code of Conduct may lead to disciplinary action in accordance to the rules and by-laws of the Carly Stowell Foundation. By signing below, I confirm that I have read and understand the above provisions and will support CSF in insisting on good sportsmanship at all times.
