

## **Player Code of Conduct**

The mission of the Carly Stowell Foundation (CSF) is to provide enhanced education in athletics and music to young people who demonstrate passion for learning and a commitment to excel. Player's adherence to this code will promote fair play, discipline and good sportsmanship for the good of the Carly Stowell Foundation. As a CSF – Jammin' Player, I agree to the following Code of Conduct:

- I will have respect for the equipment.
- I will always wear the proper uniform, in the proper manner, as directed by my Coach.
- I will not display anger directed at an opposing player, coach, referee, teammate or myself. I understand that I will be ejected from the game for this type of behavior.
- I understand that if I intentionally throw equipment, I will be subject to ejection from the game at the discretion of the umpire.
- I will play hard, but in a safe and responsible manner. I will not intentionally endanger another player in any way.
- I will not use abusive or profane language or gestures, or participate in any form of trash talk or negative cheering. I will exhibit and promote sportsmanlike conduct, encouraging my team members to cheer positively and shake hands with the opposing players after each game.

Failure to follow this Code of Conduct may lead to disciplinary action in accordance to the rules and by-laws of the Carly Stowell Foundation.
